<b>RESPECT</b>  <i>caring enough to think about what's best for yourself and others</i>	Follow directions when given.  Use kind words, body language, and actions to classmates and teachers.  Use eye contact when speaking and listening to others.  Clean up after yourself.	Hold your device safely.  T.H.I.N.K. before you post or search anything online.  Use your device away from water and food.  Use only your own device and usernames.	Allow others to join in play.  Use kind words and encourage others in your activity.  Choose fair teams.	Keep your space clean.  Say, "Please" and "Thank You" in the food line and to lunch monitors.  Use a Level-2 talking voice and use kind words.  Follow directions of lunch supervisors.	Walk quietly at a level 0 - whether alone or with your class.  Keep your hands and body from touching others' work on the walls.  Wave to friends quietly from your line.	Stay in your own space.  Look only in the stall you are using.  Flush the toilet.  Lock your stall and unlock the door when you're finished.	Follow the driver's directions.  Use a Level-2 talking voice.  Clean up after yourself.  Use kind words only.
<b>RESPONSIBILITY</b>  <i>doing things you're expected to do and accepting the consequences of your actions</i>	Have all materials ready in order to do your work.  Use work time wisely.  Accept the consequences of your actions.  Turn your work in on time.	Work collaboratively and do your part on projects.  Be safe with passwords.  Only work and talk with people you know online.  Use your device for its intended purpose.	Use equipment correctly and safely.  Problem-solve with others if issues arise.	Clean up after yourself and others.  Put your waste in the correct bins (recycle, compost, trash).  Walk to your destination safely and follow hallway expectations to and from the cafeteria.	Walk in a straight line on the right hand side of the hall so others can pass.  Use the stairs as much as possible. Save the ramps for students who need them.  Promptly return to class.	Make sure all towels and other trash go into trash cans.  Turn the water off after you're finished using the sink.  Promptly return to class.	Stay in your seat at all times, until you arrive at your bus stop.  Check your seat when you leave to make sure you have all your belongings.
<b>INTEGRITY</b>  <i>always doing the right thing and being honest, even when others aren't watching</i>	Show/help friends instead of giving them answers.  Be honest to peers and adults.  Follow the same expectations with guest teachers.	Only search appropriate topics.  Stay on the site you're supposed to be on. Close out all other tabs.  Use your own words in research.	Treat others kindly and use equipment safely, even when others are not watching.  Follow the school rules of the activity.	Demonstrate positive table manners.  Welcome any peer to sit at your table.  Eat only <u>your</u> food. Please, no sharing.  Follow the quiet signal the first time.	Go only to the destination you're supposed to be. Then return back to class. No detours!  Show others how to be a leader in the halls by your actions.	Wash your hands correctly.  Dry your hands and clean up after yourself.  Don't play around.	Being a great role model to peers.  Listen to your bus driver.  Follow bus rules, even when there is a guest driver.  Follow all school rules.
